The model railway shows in the 1990's only ever showcased a couple of N Gauge layouts. The original N Gauge Team of three passionate enthusiasts (Pauline McKenna, Steve Titheridge and Ian Atkinson) wanted more! They wanted an ALL N Gauge Show!

A show was held in 2000 initially in Wakefield but its attendance was lower than hoped for and it was decided the location was not ideal.

Graham Hubbard from Bachmann then introduced the team to the Warwickshire Event Centre and Meridienne Exhibitions. The team grew and included Pauline McKenna, Steve Titheridge, Ian Atkinson, Darren Holmes and Richard Chapman. The first show with the new team was held at the venue in 2004.

This was a great success but sadly some of the original team did not want to continue. Pauline McKenna and Steve Titheridge then formed a joint venture with Meridienne Exhibitions and held the event again in 2006, which was a huge success. The event was held again in 2008 and by then it was strong enough to become an annual event in the calendar.


Over the past 20 years we have worked together to grow the show, which is now regarded as THE Show For The Railway Modeller and is dedicated to all things N GAUGE.


As you go round the show you will see many of the main manufacturers and specialist N Gauge suppliers offering a vast range of locomotives, rolling stock and accessories.



SMALLDALE QUARRY SHIREBROOK

Ashfield is a fictional small-town station within the Great Western region. The period is the 1950's to 1960's. The layout is a single line continuous run and is controlled by DC analog. The track plan is loosely based on Ashburton with Peco code 55 track.

Barton

Construction commenced in 2017 and was completed for the WW1 centenary in late 2018. Depicting a rural station on the NER Selby to Goole line, displaying trains for the transport and the production of war materials from the surrounding area bound for the front line. Look up for the Airship!

Bad Durkhiem Ost

This is a small branch line terminus in Western Germany. The layout is an imaginary station at a real venue. The railway operates both steam and diesel traction.

This layout is based on Brinklow station, part of the Trent Valley line between Rugby and Stafford. The station opened in 1847 as Stretton and became Brinklow in 1870. There were only three sets of track running through Brinklow because of the close proximity of the canal. The stock is set in BR days between 1950 to 1965.

Broadwater Junction

This is a 'watching the trains go by' layout inspired by various coastal lines on the west coast of Wales / England such as the broad expanse of the Dovey Estuary in Wales. It has DC control with points operated by SEEP motors.

Choates Lane

Based on the East London and the High Speed One line from the channel tunnel to St Pancras International, the period is 2025 and into the future. Eurostar no longer has a monopoly on High Speed One and other companies are running trains to St Pancras International, plus freights running through from Europe and beyond.

Cucknoe depicts a fictitious cross-country route "somewhere" in rural Northamptonshire circa 1956-1962. Many former lines have provided inspiration for this layout, in fact the track plan is that of Stoke Bruerne on the former Stratford Upon Avon and Midland Junction Railway.

Denby Road

Denby Road was built in lock down so N Gauge stock could be ran. It has three lines to run mixed stock. It runs DC's on the inner track DCC on the outer track it has a

From South Germany to England

This year's layout will show different scenes along a typical modern German electrified main line. You'll pass the Monastery of "Blaubeuren", fields, rivers, farms, a typical train depot and an impressive steel bridge with a funicular at the side. At the end of the tour, you make a turn at "Stonehenge" and "Bodiam Castle". The concept is an end-to-end traffic with a fiddle yard feeding the main line with changing train sets.

Hither Green PAD

Hither Green PAD is loosely based on the engineers sidings located towards the rear of the diesel depot, during the period between 1985 and 1995. The stock is a mixture of RTR, Kit and 3D models.

Holgate

Representing the East Coast Main Line just south of York station in the late 1980's, just before electrification took place. Although "artistic licence" has been used with some of the scenic area, the track plan is as it existed at the time and the two distinctive bridges have been faithfully reproduced.

Inverkeithing

Inverkeithing is the second station after crossing the Forth bridge into the Kingdom of Fife and is situated on the north side of the Firth of Forth. It was chosen as it has the greatest number of stopping services on the line through Fife.

Long Hirston

Long Hirston is a freelance tabletop modular layout built by the Northumberland Area Group of the N Gauge Society. Its computer controlled by JMRI and operated from tablets and mobile phones. Recent additions to the layout include a working power station, coal exchange shed and automated shunting.

The concept started following an article about the Eheim trolleybus system which dates from the 1960s. The article was written by Ken Jones who with Malcolm Hall decided to build a small demonstration N Gauge layout.

Market End

Market End is a DCC N Gauge layout with 2 full working loops and a branch line that runs up to an upper level with a small market and shops. There are lots of buildings on the layout that have interior details and lighting, that add to the realism of the layout.

Set in 1985-1995 BR Railfreight/NSE period when there was still a good variety of locomotives and liveries about, based down south with 3rd rail.

North and South

On one side, a small halt north of Inverness, served now by a single track, and where the original station buildings are private homes. On the other side, Dulverton Junction in Devon based upon, (with modellers' licence), Don Breckon's painting of it. Modern and heritage stock navigate hilly, challenging countryside.

Smalldale Quarry

Smalldale is a small village situated between Buxton and Chapel-en-le-Frith. The quarry is now a popular rock climbing area. The layout is not based on the quarry but is a depiction of what it could have been like between the 1970's and 80's. The key features of the track plan are a three platform station, the quarry, a spring water bottling plant, riding stables, and a small maintenance and refuelling point.

Shirebrook

The final exhibition for Shirebrook, which depicts Shirebrook depot during the 1980's. All stock is weathered some modified. The depot station buildings and bridges are scratch built.

A village and Civil Parish in what is today known as the East Lindsey district of Lincolnshire. Mainly set in the late 60's early 70's in the British Railways green era, although the odd blue era loco and DMU can also be seen. A class 14 can sometimes be seen shunting goods to and from the brewery.

T-Trak Extravaganza

The modular layout is from the Wiltshire 5 Towns, a group of the N Gauge Society, showing what is probably the largest T-trak layout exhibited in the UK. It is some 26.5m in running length comprised of some 32 modules in a 35ft x 12ft L shaped configuration. The layout will be run as US outline layout under DCC control.

Winklesea Modular Automation

Seaside Winklesea famous for its art deco station and pickle works is the start of a modular layout focused on the automatic running of trains. Using both JMRI and Rocrail to provide computer control for multiple trains with live timetables and schedules.

Vintage N Gauge

Minitrix models planned but not made during Bachmann Europe ownership, GF Poole Scenecraft models planned but not released. Early N Gauge. Cardboard kit assembly demonstration.
