**PLEASE NOTE:** Models entered in competition classes must be the work of the exhibitor, except in exceptional circumstances and with the prior agreement of the organiser. Any model previously awarded 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> prize at the Midlands Model Engineering Exhibition may not re-enter a competition class, but may be exhibited in a display class. The Judges reserve the right to move any competition entry into another class when in their opinion the model has been entered in the incorrect class. Unfinished models should be entered into display classes only.

There are no entry charges and cash prizes are awarded where applicable.

## ENTER YOUR WORK, BE PART OF THE SHOW

All exhibitors will receive an attendance certificate. For security wherever possible all exhibits are linked to wired alarm systems; adequate barriers will protect all exhibits and night security will be maintained.

Our panel of judges will assess the entries on the first day of the show and the awards ceremony will take place on the final day of the show.
